- 1. What academic programs/ majors are the most popular at the college?
- 2. What do students like most about the school?
- 3. What is the average class size?
- 4. What makes the school special?
- 5. Do students mostly live on or off campus?
- 6. What types of scholarships does the school offer?
- 7. Do I need to take the ACT and what score is required for admission?
- 8. What GPA do I need to have to be admitted to the school?
- 9. How do they describe the academic pressure and workload?
- 10. How diverse is the school?

If you don't hear the admissions rep address the questions above, or if you have other questions, make sure to reach out to them to get your questions answered.
